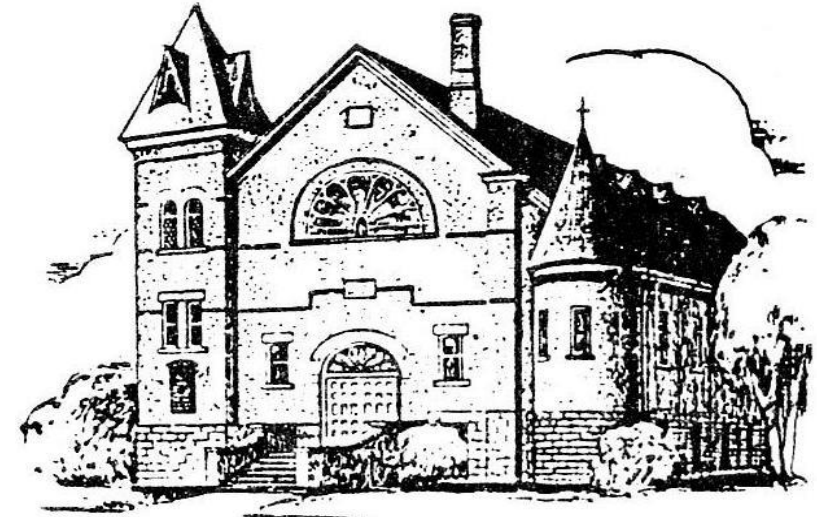

## A Few Musical Notes from Sue

Louis Vierne (1870 – 1937), a French organist and composer, was the organist at the famous Notre-Dame de Paris. Until his time, French music was known for its rich and romantic sounds. Louis brought a ‘cleaner’ sound to his organ compositions. He was so dedicated to his organ that he passed away sitting on the organ bench!

The “Prelude and Fugue in C” by J.S. Bach is part of a collection called “Eight Little Preludes and Fugues”. There is some doubt as to whether or not Bach actually wrote them. They were designed to introduce students to the art.

The melody line is introduced in the prelude. This fugue is a 3 voice fugue, meaning that the melody line will be heard in 3 different parts – in this case, the right and left hands and the feet.
